**MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING
(with Gadolinium)**

Your Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) examination is planned to include images made after an injection of gadolinium. The gadolinium injection may allow the radiologist to identify additional details about your condition that might not be apparent without the use of gadolinium. The injection will be made into a vein during your examination.

Side effects are uncommon. Infrequent side effects include headache, nausea and contrast allergies.

We do not currently use gadolinium in patients who are pregnant or nursing, or in patients with certain kinds of anemia or sickle cell disease. Please complete the checklist at the bottom of this page regarding these situations.
